

Kurhaus Centre Elisabeth Walchwil

As a guest at the Elisabeth Centre, you can make use of our treatments following a doctor's prescription or on request.

Likewise, we treat you as a patient if you need rehabilitation or aftercare following a hospital stay.

Our medical focus is divided into three areas.

- 1. Prevention**
- 2. Treatment**
- 3. Rehabilitation**



In 1995, with the establishment of the association of the Elisabeth Centre, the foundation stone was laid for our wheelchair-accessible recreation house for chronic neurological patients, especially those affected by multiple sclerosis (MS).

With the opening of the centre in autumn 1998, a longstanding request of MS patients for a care-supported place of recreation to be created, was fulfilled. The centre is classified as a 3-star hotel and covers an area of 14,000 m². It is situated in an elevated area (650 m.a.s.l.) in Walchwil on Lake Zug, in the midst of landscaped gardens and parkland and surrounded by beautiful woods and meadows. The healthy air and mild climate give this idyllic place the nickname "Zug's Nice", after the French namesake.

What is for most people a normal hotel with its wellness and SPA area, is actually also for MS sufferers a centre with specialised facilities, which are geared to the "disease pattern of MS".

The centre is recognised by the Concordat of Swiss Health Insurers (KSK) as a convalescent home or as a medically managed health resort.
